

The Annual Renewal Mission

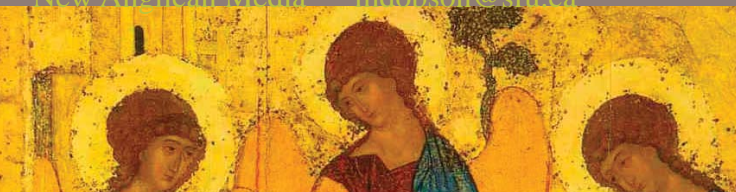
